ERIC COLE: Yeah, not a huge difference. When I get to a tournament I'm trying to play as well as I can and hopefully have a good finish. My fiancee's here with me this week and we love Napa, so it's kind of a cool spot to come play a tournament and see some of the local scenery and stuff.

Q. Does it free you up at all knowing you don't have to -- feel like you have to keep playing super well to improve? Obviously chasing a win.

ERIC COLE: Yeah, for sure. There's definitely a little bit of freedom that comes with being in that top-50 after last year and having kind of a set schedule to play and not have to worry about that too much. Kind of like as a rookie going into this year, you have a lot of questions as to which tournaments you're going to get in and which ones you aren't. So to have those tournaments is nice.

Q. Does something like a Rookie of the Year award motivate you at all or are you just kind of playing golf?

ERIC COLE: Yeah, I'd say it definitely is motivating. It's one of those things you only get one chance at it, which is something that's a little rare. Definitely something that's motivating. I'm trying to play as well as I can. If that's how it ends up, then that would be great.
