Q. Really nice round from you out there today. Just what was working well?

CAM DAVIS: Everything was working well. I was hitting my driver well, my irons for the most part was getting me in pretty good positions, I kept myself out of trouble for the most part and when I did, I got an up and down, which is really good. To keep bogeys off the card around here isn't easy and I'm always happy when I'm able to keep a whole round together like that.

Q. You've obviously secured some status for next year, a lot of other guys here don't have that. Does that free you up a little bit to just go out and chase a win?

CAM DAVIS: Yeah, if I was fighting for position for next year still, it would be a very different mindset to what I've currently got. It's nice playing with a little less stress on keeping your job and a little more focus on improving your game and working on some things that you've been working on behind the scenes. So yeah, it's nice. It's a relaxed sort of attitude and approach to the week and is leading to some good golf because I'm sure there's some good takeaways going forward.

Q. Is it allowing yourself to be more aggressive or is it just not getting caught up or worried about a shot errant here or there?

CAM DAVIS: I just think the overall vibe for the tournament for me is a little more enjoyable than stressful, which it normally is for me. I think it takes a little bit of help for me to get past that and enjoy myself out there, just soak up being in a PGA TOUR event, which when I first came out here that's what every week was like and sometimes you lose that a little bit when you're grinding for your card. I love coming here, I love the weather right now, I love how the course is playing. It's a really nice week.

Q. You mentioned to radio just a couple improvements that you want to work on. What are those specific things?

CAM DAVIS: There's a couple things in the swing, couple things, the grip, my setup. Pretty much across the board, I just want to do some upgrades, and I've got some time to be able to do that as well as playing some tournaments to test it and I think that's the perfect combination. Ideally, by the time next season comes around I've got a few things that I feel a little more comfortable with. Yeah, to see them working really well right now is certainly an encouraging sign.
