Q. Robby, 5 under today, what was working well for you out there?

ROBBY SHELTON: Yeah, just got off to a good start with the putter. I hit a few greens early and the putts fell. Kind of got me a little calmer out there and just kind of rode it. Played well on the back and had the birdie on 18 to finish it off.

Q. I believe it's your first time to the tournament here in Japan. How has the experience been so far for you?

ROBBY SHELTON: It's great, it's so much fun just seeing Asia. It's been great so far. It's just a fun tournament. The course is great, too.

Q. What works well for you on the golf course? How does it fit your eye?

ROBBY SHELTON: Usually I hit it pretty straight. So it's tree lined, you have to hit it in the fairways to play well and I'm doing that right now so it's been good.

Q. Do you see this as a place where you could break through?

ROBBY SHELTON: I think so. I've been trending in the right direction, hadn't been playing great, but it feels a lot better. Kind of figured some things out this week. Just got to keep my head on straight.

Q. Is there something about this course that suits you particularly?

ROBBY SHELTON: Not really. I just think the greens are good and I've been hitting fairways, so the putter's working and it's been good so far.
