Q. Just to start, what was decided today and why?

BRIAN CLAAR: No golf today. We woke up, we had two inches of rain last night, yesterday was a total of three, and there was literally two feet of water in the fifth fairway today. It was all the way across to 15 and 6, and 13's flooded. The maintenance crew did an incredible job with pumps, but can't get rid of the water.

Q. What's the plan for tomorrow?

BRIAN CLAAR: Plan tomorrow is we're going to play 36. We're going to start 7:15, two tees, and then we'll publish the second tee time probably halfway through tomorrow's round. We'll see the pace we're on. We'll finish tomorrow, hopefully we'll finish somewhere around 7:00.

Q. Would you re-pair?

BRIAN CLAAR: We're not going to re-pair. We're just going to have them finish, sign a card, grab a sandwich and go, and that way we can be right on time for a 4:00 live finish on Sunday.

Q. OK. Still go 54 holes, finish 4:00 p.m. on Sunday?

BRIAN CLAAR: Yes. We might get a trace tonight, but nothing we're worried about. The weather looks pretty good the next two days.
