My putting has been a mystery for a long time, but I've found a few things out the last few weeks and I've been putting really well.

Q. First win in five years out here, like I said, Hall of Fame career, 34 wins, five now on this tour. Where does this rank? Since you hadn't won in a while, is this pretty special?

VIJAY SINGH: It was a long time coming. Whenever I tee up here I always feel like, on the Champions Tour, I have a chance to win you, but never materialized. I've been working really hard. This year's been pretty good to me. I had a bad foot for the last two, three years and riding a cart really helped a lot. So I'm really happy with this win and I look forward to the next events. I think my game's coming around and this was the start of it.
