## STEVEN ALKER



Q. Obviously a special week, A, to get here, and B, just to play in it. Obviously you're familiar with it and it's somewhat of a home game for you.

Just your thoughts on the season and ending up here this week.

**STEVEN ALKER:** Thoughts on the season. Yeah, there's a bunch of second places in there, so if I turned a few of those around, I might have given Stricks a run. Still pleased. Had a win in Houston, that was an emotional win with Sam's place.

He's been -- he's the No. 1 man, I'm sure they would like to have him here and play, and we would, too, just see him finish it off in style. Yeah, it's sad news obviously for the sponsors, but yeah, we're fighting for second place, that's the big one right now.

**STEVEN ALKER:** No, no, I don't think so. Just out there just trying to win a golf tournament. Normally it's trying to beat Stricker, but I guess just trying to beat Langer and Padraig that are ahead of me at the moment, just try and get it done.

**STEVEN ALKER:** Wins always help, give that confidence, just boost carrying on, know that you finished the season strong when you played 20-odd tournaments. It would be nice to get one here, home game.
