STEPHEN AMES: I think overall it obviously is a good season. Four wins in there, in my books I grade it as a B-plus only because I thought it was a bit inconsistent. Last year was a lot more consistent where I had more opportunities to win. This year I didn't have as many, but I still won four, which is nice.

Today was -- the whole week itself, the first three days just couldn't get the putter working. Today the putter felt really nice in my hands and I made a lot of good putts coming in, which is nice.

I didn't hit the ball quite as well as I did the first three days, but that's kind of golf, how it goes.

Q. Coming out now, what's it looking like until you put the tee back in the ground in January?

STEPHEN AMES: It's not, it's in three weeks.

Q. Yes, I do know that.

STEPHEN AMES: That's kind of cutting into my downtime, yep, underneath the coconut tree unfortunately, but I can live with that for now. It should be a fun event altogether, so I'm looking forward to actually playing in it.
