Q. What's next for you?

ERIC COLE: Probably get some rest, relax a little bit, and then I'm getting married in three weeks, so just get ready for that.

Q. Where are you getting married?

ERIC COLE: The Keys, Key Largo.

Q. I know you proposed at Pebble earlier this year. I guess kind of from there your game kind of took a --

ERIC COLE: Yeah, maybe. I should have done it earlier, I guess, I'm not sure. It's been great, and we're really looking forward to the wedding and the offseason.
