Q. Some of these teams, the players just met this week. I assume you guys are a little more comfortable with each other. Does that show up especially on a stressful format like today?

COREY CONNERS: Yeah, I think so. It's pretty easy for me to be relaxed walking alongside Brooke. She's pretty -- she's always got a smile on her face out there and she's really fun to be around.
