Q. All right, Harrison, 63 today, you eagled 10 and then shot 29 on the back. How much fun was that for you?

HARRISON FRAZAR: Yeah, yeah, it was a ton of fun. I'm struggling actually a little bit ball-striking wise so I was playing to the middle or fat side on the greens just trying to stay safe, trusting my putter. And I got hot with the putter and made probably 150 feet worth of putts on the back nine. Anytime that happens you're having fun.

Q. What was the biggest difference between yesterday and today for you?

HARRISON FRAZAR: I just made some putts, yeah. I felt like the rounds were almost identical. I made a bogey today. We had the wind blowing pretty good there on 6 and kind of bounced it through the green down in the bunker. It's the only bogey in 36 holes, but other than that the rounds look really, really similar, just made some putts.

Q. Looking back to October, how much confidence did that win give you for going into tomorrow?

HARRISON FRAZAR: Yeah, a lot of confidence. I've always had confidence in my ability to play, but doing that in October has given me confidence to know that I can close it when it matters. These guys out here, they're called champions because they know how to win, they're not going to make mistakes. I need to not make mistakes. So yeah, I feel like I can do it.

Q. And you're one of four first-timers in the field this week. How special and fun has this entire week been for you?

HARRISON FRAZAR: This is the best way to start the year I can possibly imagine. It's been great, the Mitsubishi people have rolled out the red carpet for us, the golf course is amazing, the resort's fantastic. I hope I get to keep doing this for many years.
