Q. All right, Sam, 3 under today, I believe 6 under your first three rounds. How are you feeling I guess first start of the KFT here?

SAM BENNETT: Yeah, I kind of soak it up. I like the -- every tournament I hope the wind blows. Got to be creative, hit different shots and keep the ball in front of you.
