JAKE KNAPP: Yeah, it's a lot going on, for sure. You just do your best to control what you can control. You're not worried too much about what they're doing. Obviously, if something crazy happens, you've got to be ready. Just wanted to go over there, hit a few putts. Didn't really want to celebrate just yet. It was a solid week and everything else. But coming that close, I think kind of towards the back nine today we kept on saying we just want to give ourselves a chance and we were able to do that and kept hitting good golf shots. Was definitely more focused on trying to win it rather than too excited over finishing second or third.

Q. You're so early in your career, you missed more cuts than you made and then a



tournament like this happens. How much is this potentially a game changer in your mind?

JAKE KNAPP: Yeah, I think last season was probably -- on Korn Ferry was a big year for me just to go out there and feel like I'm ready for this tour and I proved that to myself.
