Q. Jason, a little bit of a mixed bag. What was the difference between yesterday and today?

JASON DAY: Just didn't hit enough fairways today. I hit actually good drives for the most part and then just missed (indiscernible,) makes it difficult to hit the greens. When you're not quite, you know, sharp enough like I was yesterday with my short game, then that obviously makes it a little bit tough.

Q. Is that an adjustment that you need to make going into tomorrow or --

JASON DAY: Yeah, hit more fairways would be good. I mean, like I can't --

Q. But in terms of like going out to the range, trying to work on it --

JASON DAY: No, I mean, that's just -- I think I -- I definitely know the problem, but sometimes you have days where you're just slightly missing 'em. And this is where some of the swing changes and the inconsistency of changing a swing can happen. But overall I'm just -- yeah, I'm obviously very pleased with where I'm at, but I know that I could be a lot better considering where I was after 10 and three-putting 11 and then bogeying 12 and 13.

Q. Apologies if you were asked this yesterday, but in your first few starts here you didn't have the results that you were hoping for and then last year finishing T-9, was it something that you found out here or just playing better golf?

JASON DAY: Yeah, I think it's just a little bit of attitude definitely goes a long way. Obviously when you come here and you don't quite -- you aren't sharp off the tee and then you just -- like I said today, like if you're not quite sharp off the tee, you miss a lot of greens and if your short game's not kind of showing up, and these greens are a little tricky to read and they're fast, then that is a formula for like not a lot of success.

But I think you kind of -- first and foremost, when you have results at a golf course, you have to try and change the mentality, then just try and change a few things. I feel like I've gained a lot more accuracy over the last few years, so that definitely helps obviously at this golf course.
