CRISTOBAL DEL SOLAR (-15)



Q. So 2 under today, still a solid round over at the Lagos course. How is it playing over there compared to yesterday?

CRISTOBAL DEL SOLAR: Yeah, I mean, they're completely different courses. One of them is longer, the other one's short. It's a lot of 8-irons, 7-irons into the greens, tighter tee shots as well, and the pins are tucked. As expected, that's a championship course.

Yeah, I mean, I actually had a solid round. I hit the ball great, gave myself plenty of looks for birdie. A few of them went in, a few of them didn't, but hit good putts. Yeah, I'm happy with my round.

Q. Did you ever feel yourself maybe just pressing a little bit coming off a 57 and then you're not rolling in birdie after birdie today? Did you feel pressure to be making stuff or --

CRISTOBAL DEL SOLAR: No, not really. I knew how the course is. I mean, I played it last year. It's a difficult -- I wouldn't say -- yeah, it is difficult. Maybe this year is not as difficult as the last couple years. Obviously definitely more difficult than the last one that I played yesterday.

I'm happy, I'm happy where I'm at. I'm happy I'm putting myself in this position, you know, more. I'm playing great. I don't think I really pushed it, I just kind of stick with my plan, just tried to play good golf.

Q. Does strategy off the tee change much over there compared to Pacos? I know it's a lot of driver and get it down there.

CRISTOBAL DEL SOLAR: Yeah, yeah, of course. Pacos is just hitting it as far as you can near the green. This other one is more irons off the tee, 3-woods and, like I said, just tighter tee shots. On 18 you have to hit a massive slice of the tree and just kind of fit it in the fairway.

Yeah, I mean, they're completely different courses, you can't really compare them. You just have to build a strategy for each course and just stick to it. And I've done that, so hopefully it goes well on the weekend.

Q. And we were talking Aldrich posted a 59 at Pacos, didn't quite catch you. Any



relief knowing he wasn't able to get down to your number?

CRISTOBAL DEL SOLAR: I mean, yeah. I mean, anybody that shoots under 60, it's unbelievable. Like I said, I've only done it once, which was yesterday. Great for him, I'm happy that he broke 60. He's obviously playing good golf, he won in Abaco and he's a great player.

Q. Thoughts on chances that you're going to end up playing with him tomorrow?

CRISTOBAL DEL SOLAR: Yeah, I mean, probably. I just quickly saw the leaderboard on my last hole so that's how I knew he played well. Yeah, he's a good player, so I'll be watching good golf if we play together.

Q. And just kind of thoughts going into the third round tomorrow?

CRISTOBAL DEL SOLAR: Just the same. Like I said before, just stick with my plan, my routines. Just nothing really changes on a weekly basis, so just keep doing the same thing.

Q. Can you talk about the swing change that you made?

CRISTOBAL DEL SOLAR: Why, did they post a video from like six years ago?

Yeah, I mean, no words. No, I've been working a lot with my coach, Eduardo Miquel. For anybody that's going through a swing change, just stick to it, it's going to get better, that's for sure. I went through it, it got better, more consistent. And I'm still going through it, still trying to improve, better technique, better trajectories.

But it has evolved in a very nice way for me. I can see it on the trajectories of my ball flight and control and I'm very happy with how I'm doing and with my coach. I think we're working on the right stuff.

Q. Has that really been over the past year you've been working on that?

CRISTOBAL DEL SOLAR: No, it's been going for probably four years when I decided, you know what, we're going to -- I want to be a really, really good player, so we're going to have to improve. Yeah, that's when I decided to work with him. That's when we started working, maybe four years ago, five years ago, I don't remember exactly. Yeah, just happy, happy how the things are working out and hopefully it ends up really good in my career.

Q. And does it feel good starting to see those results after four years of working on it?

CRISTOBAL DEL SOLAR: Yeah, of course. Yeah, last year was -- no, two years ago on the Latin America Tour, that's when I really got really consistent. I don't really remember, I think the season was like 12 events and I had like maybe eight or nine top-5s or something.



It was really good golf.

Then obviously played well on the Korn Ferry last year. I think that's when obviously you grab more confidence in yourself, the things that we're doing are the right things. Yeah, like I said, I'm very happy with it.
