Q. Xander, how would you kind of characterize how the day went for you?

Q. When you holed the bunker shot on 11, when you're going to the 12th tee, what were you kind of thinking?

XANDER SCHAUFFELE: I have a chance to win now. Yeah, I was sort of a little bit slow through nine holes. Then after holing the bunker shot, I knew I was within at least a couple shots of the lead. Just some really, like I said, some really -- I wasn't able to hit the 12th fairway once, 12th or 13th fairway once this week, which is a big bummer. Just with the length, if I can shape it correctly I can actually get a scoring iron in my hand. But I was 0-8 in that stretch, so look forward to coming back next year.

Q. Last question, do you feel like what you're working on is making positive signs in your game going forward here?

XANDER SCHAUFFELE: I do, yeah. It's funny, I literally, as soon as I felt like I was getting in some good flow, I stopped working on what I was working on and I think I reverted back to some old stuff that isn't very good, hence some of those bad shots. Just got to keep doing what I'm doing.
