Q. Opening round, what did you like about your round today?

DAVID LIPSKY: Well, obviously the putter was hot. I can't remember the last time I made that many -- that footage in putts in a given round. Felt like I was due, I feel like I've been putting pretty nicely and sometimes they just drop for you.

Q. Is there anything you've been working on leading up to this week with the putter or just kind of fell in place?

DAVID LIPSKY: Since about the middle of last year I started working with Cameron McCormick and he's really helped me. Feel like I have a better understanding of my putting and how to putt well, I think that's helped me, and I've trying to get better and better since we started working.

Q. Any birdies or shots stick out in particular from the round?

DAVID LIPSKY: Holing a couple putts on the front nine actually, they were like mid range, probably like 10 to 15 feet after making a couple bogeys to help me get back to even par really helped me sort of steady the ship and felt like I could play a little bit more freely through the rest of the round.

Q. Played here, seen the course, top-10 your first year. What do you like about it matching your game?

DAVID LIPSKY: I just like that you've got to hit a lot of shots out here because it is windy. You have to hit it to the right portions of the green, they're slopey in spots. I think that's helped me and given me an advantage, I sort of know where to hit it and where not to hit it.

Q. Tougher start to the season, but mentioned the putter's feeling hot. What's kind of takeaways from this round?

DAVID LIPSKY: I think rounds like this give you a lot to build on. My swing feels like it's getting back to where I want to be and obviously the putter was good today. That's a pretty good combination.
