Q. Have you had a different mindset coming into this week knowing that there's familiarity here with your son on the bag to tomorrow what could happen?

RICARDO GONZALEZ: Yeah, the Argentinian -- all the Argentinian feeling good with the people and especially with my son on the bag, can do anything, everything.

Q. This is your 13th event on PGA TOUR Champions. Getting this win, you know, guarantees you a whole season, like Al said. Is there extra drive and motivation this week to do that?

RICARDO GONZALEZ: Yes, yes, for sure, goal motivation. If you play good tomorrow, have a chance to play more for the tournament. So very happy for that.

Q. If you can describe the second round, how would you describe it?

RICARDO GONZALEZ: Today the first three or four holes very tough because of rain and no hit so well. Then after the fifth hole started to play good and make some putt and make a good score.

Q. And how did you find the golf course?

RICARDO GONZALEZ: Yeah, the golf course is great. The (indiscernible) Argentinian course and that's why I feeling comfortable here.
