Q. Emiliano, 4 under round today, your thoughts about this Saturday here at Vidanta?

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yeah, played four years in Europe, he was kind of a, I don't want to say dad figure because I don't think he's that old, but yeah, he was a bit of an uncle, like a little bit of -- you could call it a little bit of a father figure out there. Great person, I love him. Super excited. I was excited all morning. I woke up and he was in the lead with 10 holes to go. It was a bit of a long and bit of a stressful morning, but I'm glad it worked out and hopefully I'll get to see him more often.

Q. How important is it for Argentina to have these kind of players playing at these high levels?

EMILIANO GRILLO: It opens the door for everybody, just seeing that somebody can do it and then you can go and kind of follow the same path and knowing that if you're 40, 45, you're getting ready for the Champions Tour and you can make it. I mean, he made it from scratch and it was from -- I know how hard he fought to get where he's at right now. Hopefully, many more can follow that.
