

BRICE GARNETT (-6)

Q. Brice, great opening to your eighth, I think, Puerto Rico Open start. A couple eagles today certainly helped you. Take me through the round a little bit.

BRICE GARNETT: Yeah, it was nice this morning. Got out there before any wind picked up and was able to get to 15 I guess into with the tee up, so that was a nice little added benefit this morning. And then played really nice, hit the driver really well. Only one sloppy three-putt on my back nine but came back with a big chip-in on No. 6 for eagle, and made a nice one on No. 9 to finish up the day.

Q. You've had some good success here in the past, a couple of top-10 finishes in your last three starts, and I was looking, if I counted, right 22 of your last 23 rounds have been par or better. You obviously like the course here?

BRICE GARNETT: I'm very comfortable around here. I love the wind and I just, I love some of the drives out here, they kind of put an emphasis on hitting good, straight shots, especially with the wind moving the ball a lot. So I've always putted well on these greens here and in the Dominican and then back in Mayakoba back in the day. Very comfortable and just excited to actually get my first PGA TOUR start of the year, so it's all good.

Q. And final question based on that, what is it you're coming into feeling good about as far as your game goes? Anything that's kind of coming around?

BRICE GARNETT: I've worked hard since before fall of last year, kind of changed my swing and it's felt really good at home. Then coming out here on the course during tournament weeks, I just haven't made it pay off yet. So been playing a lot at home, putting up a lot of good numbers and I guess with my comfort level around here, everything just kind of fell into place today.
