

### SCOTT PIERCY (-7)

Q. Scott, that was a heck of a round. Where do we even start with the highlights. Had 5 under through six holes, mainly highlighted at the 14th hole. If you can just kind of take me through with some clubs and yards.

**SCOTT PIERCY:** Yeah, holed it from the fairway, I think I had 176. I guess I was in the rough, but you don't plan on holing it from the rough or from the fairway very often. I had 176, kind of a little wind down off the right. I thought it was going to jump so I hit an 8-iron, landed about three yards short and trickled in the hole.

#### Q. Well, 8-under 64 is great round. You birdied the last three holes to get it done.

**SCOTT PIERCY:** Seven under, I got 7 under.

### Q. You finished at 7, I'm sorry, my bad. Giving you too much credit.

SCOTT PIERCY: I wish it was 8.

# Q. Birdies on your last three. Just overall about the whole round, obviously a lot felt good I would imagine.

**SCOTT PIERCY:** Yeah, I had a couple good breaks. On 8 there I kind of tugged my tee shot in the bunker and it plugged. I actually holed it from a plugged lie out of the bunker on No. 8. I had a couple good breaks today.

I actually hit some good iron shots that were close enough to make and roll in, and the putter cooperated pretty well today. So anytime you make, what did I make, an eagle and like eight birdies or something, whenever you're making a lot of birdies. I hit some really good shots, like hit a really good shot into 2, to land it on the green, keep it on the greens on the par 5s, so made for an easy birdie. Then I played most of the hard holes pretty well.

# Q. Final question, top 21 last year here, just thoughts on the course, how it kind of sets up, suits your game.

**SCOTT PIERCY:** I think you've got to drive it pretty well because you get a lot of crosswinds. I don't want to say it's easier this year because it's playing longer, but with the softness, it takes out some of the trouble on some of the holes.

I holed it with an 8-iron on 14, I had an 8-iron into 13 that I hit about 15 feet. I had like five or six 8-irons today, which is kind of like the meat of my game.

The par 5s are a little bit longer this year so it's a little bit harder to reach them because the ball's not rolling out. I think I got two of the par 5s, so if I can keep hitting my irons pretty solid, I rolled it nice today, which was a big change from the last few weeks.
