So I didn't look, I was just trying to like obviously birdie the last hole and gave myself a nice chance with a left-to-right putt but it went straight, so it was just a par on the last.

Q. This is going to be your best result of the season. What changed in your game to feel better here in Puerto Rico?

VICTOR PEREZ: I think I've been just trending nicely. I think the last three weeks I've been better every week. I obviously missed a couple cuts to start the season, which wasn't ideal. I had some health issues at the start of the year and then I've been better the last three weeks, so it's a nice progression and I'm looking forward to playing in the Valspar in a couple weeks.
