## Q. Obviously not the outcome you wanted, but what's going through your head right now?

**STEVEN ALKER:** Yeah, obviously some disappointment to finish. I didn't do too much in terms of ball-striking, didn't do too much wrong. I kind of hit the shots I wanted and went with them. Yeah, just putting wasn't -- just didn't make some putts I should have, the three-putt on 17 there. So felt fine, my long game felt good, just didn't get it done.

## **Q.** Specific to the decision to go for it in two on 18, can you talk through that a little bit?

**STEVEN ALKER:** Yeah. I mean, it was just a really good solid 5-iron. I had a super lie, could almost hit driver off the lie in the semi-rough there, that's how good the lie was.

If I hit rescue, then I flush it and it's gone through the green. So just got a little high on the face, a little grassy. It got over. I kind of flew the front, but just got maybe a little unlucky.

## Q. What was the yardage?

**STEVEN ALKER:** 199 to the front.

## Q. With a 5-iron?

**STEVEN ALKER:** With a 5-iron. Just got a little high on the face and just kind of come out soft. I was happy with that. If I get it on the front, I'm still going for a two-putt.
