TONY FINAU (-11)

Q. Tony, a nice round to cap off the week. How would you kind of describe the day as a whole?

TONY FINAU: Yeah, it was nice, nice to finish the way I did. Missed a short one on 16 that hopefully's not going to cost me the tournament. Still a little bit shaken by that, but overall it was a really nice week as I look forward to playing Augusta National.

Q. Is it hard to kind of look past some of those things when you get in, kind of the what-ifs?

TONY FINAU: Yeah, looks like 12 may have a great chance. Again, just, you know, didn't make a crucial putt when I really needed it, but who knows how I finish, if I make it. That's the game we play. But I was happy to finish with really solid shots down the last couple holes and just to birdie the last couple.

Q. With your game heading towards Augusta, what are you happy with your game and what do you feel you kind of need to work on in the next like week?

TONY FINAU: I drove it really nicely this week, that's huge at Augusta National. If I'm driving it long and straight around that place, it becomes very scorable. That's going to be a huge weapon for me if I want to win the Masters. I was very happy with that. But all parts of the game, it's nice to have a good finish. That's what I was looking for this week. I didn't have some of my best results, I felt like I was putting some good work in over the past month and not getting good results out of it, so it's nice to get a nice result after a solid week.

Q. So it's not just physical stuff, it's also like a mental picture as well?

TONY FINAU: Yeah, no doubt. I think you want to have some confidence going into Augusta National. A win would have been nice this week, but just to put yourself in contention, feel the nerves, I think that's important leading up to a big tournament.
